FUNDRAISING COMMITMENT

We need to pay for most of the mission expenses well before the mission trip begins. Each Team member accepts responsibility for meeting his/her personal fundraising goal of **\$525**. Fundraising goals include: food, lodging, transportation, etc.

Participation in the opportunities below can proportionally reduce his/her personal fundraising goal:

- **STOCK SALES: December 9, 2018- May 31, 2019**
- **SCRATCH & HELP: December 9, 2018- May 31, 2019- \$80 per Booklet**
- **BAKE SALE: February 16 & 17, after all masses- 1st Mass- \$10 | Each Additional Mass-\$5 | \$5 for Baking**
- **CAR WASH: May 4 & 5, during all masses (except 7:30am)- 1st Mass- \$15 | Each Additional Mass-\$5 | \$5 for Setup**

The payment schedule is as follows: \$100 nonrefundable deposit with application. Payments of \$100 on: January 25, March 29, April 26, and a payment of \$125 on May 31. Payments may vary based on fundraising efforts. If you are still a team member on February 1st, you owe at least 50%, and on April 1st, 100% will be owed if you decide to drop your spot on the team.

CHWC SNACKS

It is a tradition for St. Mary's Youth Ministry to be "well prepared" with snacks for not only the long bus ride, but also for the entirety of the mission trip. We ask each team member to bring a snack to share for the whole team (about 40 people). Individual snacks work best as they are easier to throw in a big plastic bin. You will bring these snacks to our luggage drop off night on June 22nd before mass. At a later date we will section off a group of people who will be in charge of bringing breakfast for the bus ride (ex: pop tarts, granola bars, muffins, etc.). Everyone else will be in charge of bringing a normal snack (ex: fruit snacks, gold fish, chips, etc.). Furthermore if you would like to donate mini bottles of Gatorade you can do that as well, but it is not mandatory.

We also need about 3-4 big plastic bins and 4-5 coolers that we can use for the week of the mission trip. This is optional, but we greatly appreciate anyone who will let us borrow these supplies.
